

BANG

School Years: 2-8

Group Size: 6-30

Aim: For students to remain in the game by responding faster than their opponent.

How To Play: For this Western-themed game, everyone must stand in a circle. Choose one person to stand in the centre, holding their hands together to form a gun. This person is the caller. They point at someone around the circle and call “bang”. The person they point at must duck down, and the two people on either side must shoot at each other and say “bang”. The person who calls “bang” last is out. If someone calls “bang” at the wrong time, or if someone doesn’t duck fast enough, they are also out. The person in the centre has the final say.
